

Guided tours, lectures and workshops on bicycle planning and bicycle infrastructure in Amsterdam

ML Advies organizes tours, lectures and workshops on bicycle-inclusive planning and infrastructure in Amsterdam, and the Netherlands. About how cycling can contribute to create smart, healthy and sustainable cities, towns and regions.

These programs offer insight into the opportunities and challenges of cycling-inclusive planning and show technical and social aspects of these policies.

The programs are directed by professionals in bicycle inclusive planning who are well informed on bicycle inclusive facilities and traffic policy in Amsterdam and the Netherlands.

Details

- A program can consist of
 - o a guided tour by bike (or on foot or in a bus)
 - o a workshop
 - o and/or a lecture and discussion.
- In general a program takes about 3 hours, shorter or longer can be discussed
- The content will be customized to customers preferences (see list below)
- Price: €70 (starting tariff) + €85 per hour duration of the program. This is excl. 21% VAT. (for state recognized educational institutes VAT can be omitted)
- The fee is to be paid in cash at the day of the program, or well in advance through bank booking.
- For tours by bicycle:
 - o Max. 15 participants per guide
 - The professional guide will chose a safe route
 - o Participants cycle at their own risk and responsibility
 - Bicycle rental is to be arranged by the customer and is not included in the price.
 - Bikes can be rented at many places in Amsterdam. Such as: <u>www.macbike.nl</u> www.yellowbike.nl (and more)
 - Room for presentation is (in principal) to be arranged by the customer.
